### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Investigators are general members who assist and conduct onsite and offsite paranormal research and investigations. Investigators also assist with setup and takedown duties, evidence review, and other assigned duties.



### SPECIFIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assists with equipment setup and takedown.
- Assists and conducts paranormal research onsite and offsite
- Keeps log of subjective and objective events during investigation.
- Assists and conducts research offsite as necessary.
- Assists with evidence review and analysis after investigations.
- Contributes to team discussions and case analysis.
- Responsible for safety during onsite investigations.
- Actively seeks to expand knowledge of the paranormal field by reading, taking classes, and personal research.

### QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Must have a car, a valid driver's license, and a reasonably clean driving record.
- Must own a computer with Internet access (preferably high-speed).
- Must have good computer skills and able to navigate MS Windows or MAC, transfer data from audio/camera devices to computer, and upload evidence to team member's area.
- Must become familiar with the general operation of all equipment in inventory including digital video cameras, digital cameras, digital audio recorders, EMF meters, and other electronic items.
- Must have a cell phone.
- Must be dependable and reliable and not have a criminal record.
- Must be able to communicate in a clear, understandable, patient, and personable manner, including *regular* communication with Founder/Director.
- Must have excellent writing skills including knowledge of spelling, punctuation, and grammar.
- Must have the ability to participate in occasional investigations usually on weekends.
- Must maintain a professional, positive, and team-oriented attitude in which you contribute toward the growth, development, and success of the team.
- Must have the ability to think for yourself and must possess an open mind (healthy skepticism is fine, but no hard-core skeptics wanted).
- Must pay own transportation and incidental expenses (everyone pays their own way).
- Must have a stable life (which in most cases includes having a job, unless you are independently wealthy).
- Must contribute to team discussions and attend team meetings.
- Must follow and abide by the team's Standards and Protocols.
